



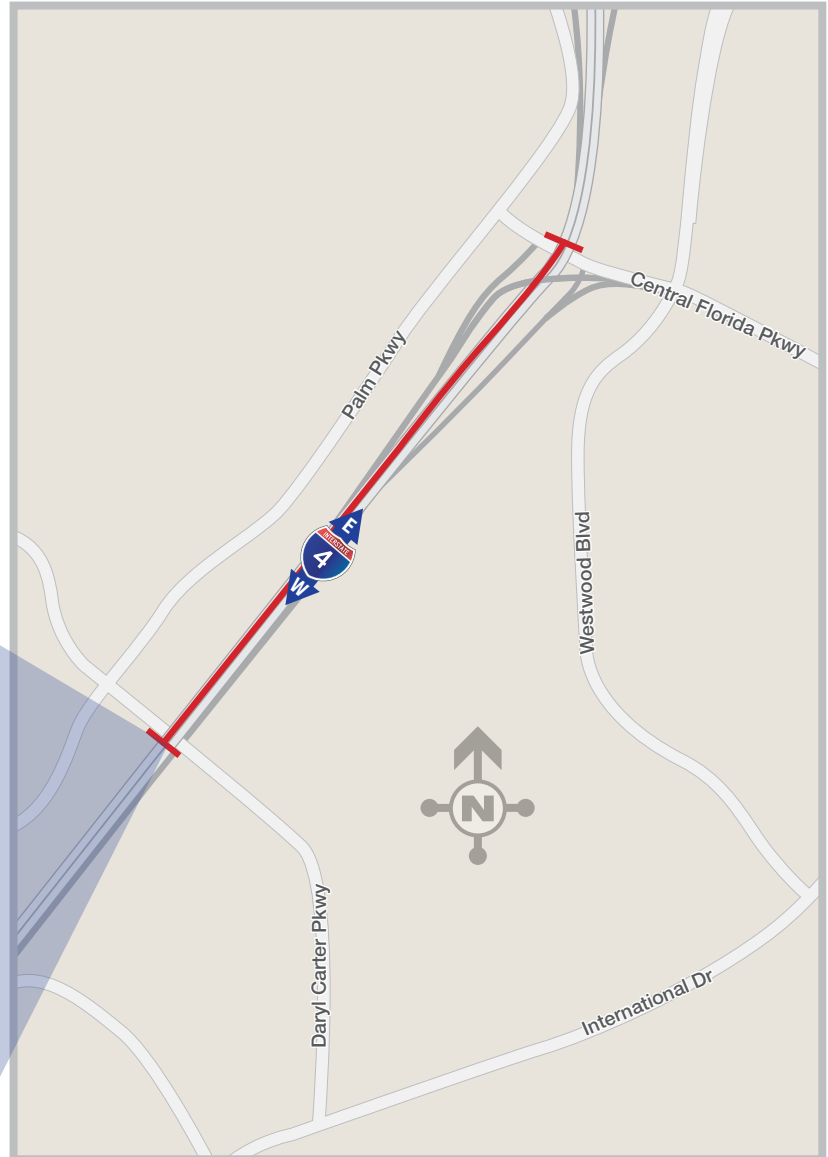

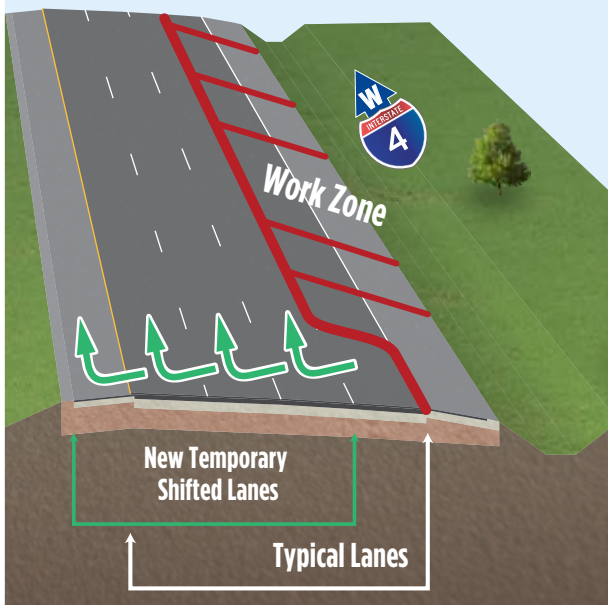

WESTBOUND I-4 FROM CENTRAL FLORIDA PARKWAY TO DARYL CARTER PARKWAY SHIFTING OCTOBER 18

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is shifting traffic on westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) roughly 12 feet towards the median of I-4 from Central Florida Parkway to Daryl Carter Parkway. Double lane closures on westbound I-4 are scheduled to begin as soon as 9 p.m. Wednesday, October 18 and are expected to be complete by 6:30 a.m. Thursday, October 19. The closures are necessary to complete the shift. The traffic shift is anticipated to be in place until spring 2024 and will provide space for crews to complete drainage and lighting work.
